

SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS FOR PERMISSION TO PHOTOGRAPH AND USE PICTURES OF ARCHAEOLOGICAL CONTENT IN ELECTRONIC PUBLICATIONS (E-BOOKS)

For permission to photograph monuments, archaeological sites, places of historical importance and museums as well as for permission to use pictures of archaeological content in electronic form (e-book), it is required to first complete the relevant form.

- The supporting documents accompanying the application form for permission to photograph monuments, archaeological sites, places of historical importance and museums must include the clarification of whether they refer to more than one monument which is under the jurisdiction of the Ministry of Culture and Sports or not.
- The supporting documents accompanying the application form for permission to use pictures of archaeological content in an electronic publication (e-book) are the following:
 1. Information about whether the request refers, in total, to more than one monument which is under the jurisdiction of the Ministry of Culture and Sports.
 2. Certification from the publisher about whether access to the e-book is free of charge.
 3. Information about whether permission for a printed version has preceded or whether it is going to be required simultaneously.

It must be noted that, as of now, a copy of the receipt of payment of the respective fees to the Archaeological Receipts Fund must be sent to the Directorate of Museums within one month from receipt of the relevant permission granting Decision.
